COMMITTEE REPORT 2018/2019

The Committee have continued their work on behalf of the Association, with monthly meetings held at the Milford Arms. We have provided advice and information to some Members on specific matters of concern to them. We have notified the Council regarding problems such as illegal dumping of waste materials, litter and traffic problems in our area.

We have continued to participate in many organisations including the Resident Association Forum (RAF) and G15+ giving us access to local matters relating to the SGRA area, Safer Neighbourhood Local Policing Team, NHS Clinical Commissioning Group and HACAN. We are grateful to Margaret Thorburn for her updates on HACAN activities.

On behalf of the Association, the Committee would like to express appreciation to Danny Rybowski for representing SGRA at meetings held by several organisations and providing us with their reports. Also, for forwarding Met.Police (OWL) news.

Newsletters have been distributed regularly throughout the year, bringing Members up-to-date with planning applications and local issues. In addition, helpful articles on various general subjects have been included. Terry Chilvers has assisted in the preparation and printing of the Newsletter which are delivered by our Street Reps. Geoff Miles agreed to undertake updating our website. Their contribution is much appreciated.

Our Newsletters, e-mails and website conform with the requirements of GDPR.

The Police Safer Neighbourhood Team have continued to provide crime prevention advice and updates on local matters. Their e-mail distribution service has enabled members who subscribed to receive current news.

Councillors Tony Louki and Unsa Chaudri have joined us at Committee meetings and we would like to thank them for their interest in our organisation.

The ongoing matter regarding the decision by TfL to drastically remove trees and shrubbery along the railway line in Spencer Road has yet to be resolved. The Council are looking into the traffic problems created in Thornbury Road between Eversley Crescent and Oakley Gardens due to cars being parked on both sides of the road and we await the outcome of their investigation.

In June we again held a 'Picnic in the Park' in Thornbury Park in support of the Nationwide Community Events programme. More members attended this year and we were very pleased that we were joined by Brentford & Isleworth MP Ruth Cadbury and Councillors Unsa Chaudri and Richard Eason.

In July, the Plant Sale organised by Polly and Terry Chilvers to raise funds for charity was very popular.

In December our annual Christmas Get-together with buffet was held at the Milford Arms. This has proved to be a successful social event and the Committee are encouraged by the increase in members attending.

We are pleased to report that Membership has again shown a small increase on last year and the Committee would like to thank all Association Members for their continued support.
