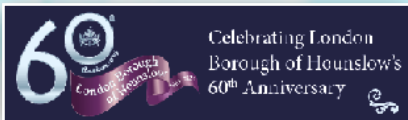
197 Spring Grove Road

GILLETTE CLOCK TOWER INAUGURAL CEREMONY

At the invitation of Councillor Aftab Siddiqui, residents joined him on the 31st July for the Inaugural Ceremony of the newly restored Gillette Clock Tower. The ribbon-cutting was carried out by Cllr Junue Meah, the Deputy Mayor, at the steps to the main building. He also gave the inaugural address. Details of the restoration of the tower and work required to bring the clock back to working order were explained.

The much-loved landmark, a striking feature of the Golden Mile skyline, had fallen into disrepair in recent years. But now, thanks to a partnership between Hounslow Council and the Vinyl Factory (the leaseholder of the Gillette Building), the historic clock has been fully renovated and is once again keeping time for the local community.
