Overhanging shrubbery

The council requires overhanging foliage to be cut back to eight foot above the highway. Please keep shrubs trimmed back from the pavement. If excess growth from street trees or overhanging shrubbery/bushes is a problem you can report it via the Hounslow Highways site (Enquiry Description – Trees shrubs & vegetation – over hanging branches). If you do not have internet access you can phone 020 8583 5555 but be prepared for a long wait (best to avoid reporting on a Monday or at lunchtime).

Free Wills Month

Over 55s in England and Wales who have not made a will can get one drawn up for free. This scheme, which takes place twice a year in October and in March, lets people draw up a simple will with help from a solicitor free of charge. People who benefit are asked to make a donation to charities backing the scheme. The usual fee for this service is £150 plus VAT. See freewillsmoonth.org.uk for details
