HACAN and Heathrow

The Davies Commission set a short deadline in May for a last-minute consultation on Air Quality ie pollution. Once responses have been digested the report will be published recommending one of the runway options.

Quote from BBC:

'Sir Howard Davies, the chairman of the Airports Commission, has decided to take further evidence on problems caused by air pollution.

'His decision comes after a Supreme Court ruling in April, ordering the UK to do more to improve air quality.

'The commission has already recommended three options for a new runway.

'The consultation ended on Friday 29 May.

'The final report was expected in June, but could now be delayed as a result of the consultation.'

Much is being made in the press of conditions likely to be set in particular around either Heathrow option. Although HACAN understands that some residents may have been persuaded they would benefit if these conditions were met as a consequence of a 3rd runway going ahead, it does not favour expansion in principle.

Better Care for Hounslow Residents

Health and social care rehabilitation services for Hounslow adults will be brought together under an innovative new partnership initiative between Hounslow and Richmond Community Healthcare NHS Trust (HRCH) and Hounslow Council. The Hounslow Community Recovery Service aims to help people recover and regain their independence after a serious illness, injury or change in life circumstances - including neurological conditions such as a stroke, multiple sclerosis, or Parkinson's. By integrating different health and social care specialists from the local NHS trust and council into a single team, the service is able to provide more coordinated and responsive care for local people to help them recover more quickly and effectively following illness or injury. It brings together therapists, specialist nurses, and rehabilitation assistants from HRCH with social workers, occupational therapists and support workers from Hounslow Council into a single, easy to access service. The new service will operate seven days a week, 365 days a year, between 8am to 8pm. This is to ensure patients get the right support and care at the right time to improve their rehabilitation. Care and support from the team is provided to patients in their own homes or in other local community locations. In order to qualify for the service, people must be aged 18 or over, registered with a Hounslow GP, or be a resident within Hounslow borough and require rehabilitation or reablement after an acute illness, injury or change in life circumstances, with a primary physical or social need. Referrals can be made by GPs or other healthcare professionals. The service also accepts self-referrals.
