3rd Runway or not?

The Government has not yet decided on a 3rd runway at Heathrow. It is considering the report in which The Airports Commission recommended a 3rd runway largely on the basis of the economic benefits it would bring to the country. However, some readings of evidence in the Commission's own report show that the predictions are not entirely convincing.

There were also stringent conditions to be met eg on noise, flightpaths and future expansion which may well not be achievable.

Serious doubts remain as to whether Heathrow will be able to meet EU legal limits on air pollution. Any theoretical plan to achieve this depends on a large number of measures to reduce emissions including constraints on everyone else around Heathrow.

A leaflet has been sent to residents in boroughs likely to be affected by the proposed 3rd runway making some of these points. Heathrow has a very large public relations budget to try and persuade people to support its plan but in most places people are not convinced by it. A rally is planned for 10 October.

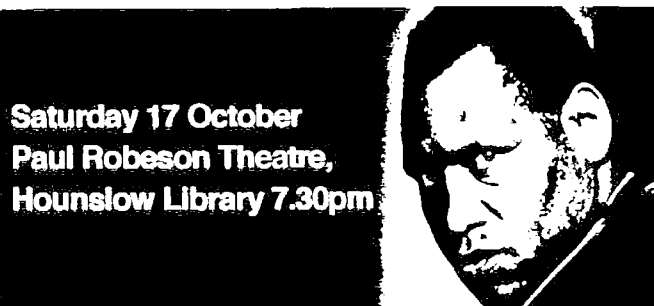
