Did You Know?

Andrew Pears was the third generation head of the Pears Soap business located in Isleworth and in 1886 he bought Spring Grove House. He rebuilt it in 1892/94 on a grander scale, retaining the structure, facing the building with new red brickwork, and adding large rear extensions. This created a sizeable mansion, most of which still stands. The house is now part of West Thames College.

New appointment system - Starting 4th January 2016

The new system will give the patient the option of booking a face-to-face appointment with a GP or nurse practitioner on the day, or a telephone consultation with a GP on the day.

On 1st Feb 2015 the telephone triage system was launched on a trial basis. The triage system was trialled for 10 months and after considerable review of patient and staff feedback, the practice has decided to revert back to a face-to-face appointment system.

It was noted that some patients do prefer a telephone consultation on the day, and so a number of on the day telephone appointment slots have been included.

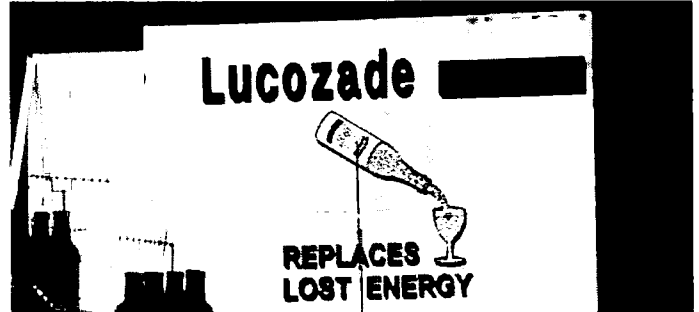
These changes will not affect the booking of routine appointments and routine telephone appointments, which can be booked up to 2 weeks in advance.

If you wish to book a SAME-DAY appointment, you will need to contact the practice from 8.30am. We will no longer be taking same-day appointment requests at 2.30pm.

So, if you feel unwell and want advice from a GP:

- Call reception from 8.30am and press option 1 to book an appointment
- The receptionist will ask if you want to come in and see a doctor or nurse practitioner or if you want to speak to a GP over the phone.
- If you want to see the doctor or nurse practitioner, you will be given an appointment time on that day
- If you want to speak to a GP, you will be given a one hour window (on the same day) in which the GP will call you back.

Bring back The Iconic Lucozade Sign



Over the Christmas Holiday 2015, the much loved iconic Lucozade sign, which has adorned the Great West Road at Brentford, since around 1954, was removed and replaced by a digital sign.

This has previously gone to full planning, with the London Borough of Hounslow who rejected the planning application. The decision was appealed to the Planning Inspectorate and then given permission with restrictions.

The sign was removed over the Christmas Holidays so that the rules could not be looked at, and therefore, any breaches could take place whilst London Borough of Hounslow was enjoying a break for the year.

This is similar to the way the iconic Firestones building was knocked down, which was done during a bank holiday break, so that there could be no objections.

A petition to get 100,00 signatures and raise support for not only Hounslow and its residents, who have enjoyed this sign for years, but those who enjoy the history of this sign, and those who enter London each day and enjoy seeing this sign, and want it back.
