Did You Know?

Thomas Harriot made the first drawing of the Moon using a telescope and the first telescopic observations of sunspots at Syon House in Brentford. He had surveyed Virginia with Walter Raleigh, obtained one of the early 'Dutch trunk' telescopes and set about making astronomical observations with it, seemingly before Galileo. Harriot was at the time in the pay of the Earl of Northumberland, and lived at the latter's Syon House.

To celebrate the 400th anniversary of Thomas Harriot's historic observations of the Moon, Lord Egremont of Petworth unveiled a memorial plaque. It is sited close to the location of Harriot's observations of the Moon on July 26th 1609

- The opportunity to audition for LCT Youth Company Shows, some of which will be taken to the Edinburgh Fringe Festival
- Career support from the Managers of London Contemporary Theatre, a renowned professional theatre company
- Headshot and CV
- Free or reduced priced tickets for all Hounslow Arts Centre performances
- Free use of the dance studio for private practice whenever the space is available.

What is the cost?

The youth company is completely FREE. In return for membership all members must complete fifteen hours of volunteering for Hounslow Arts Centre or London Contemporary Theatre per term.

Where does it take place?

The weekly workshops take place at Hounslow Arts Centre every Tuesday 5.30pm-7.30pm

How do I get involved?

Members of the Youth Company are carefully selected via auditions.

When's the next audition day?

Tuesday 13th December 2016, 5pm-8pm at Hounslow Arts Centre

Do all applicants get offered an audition?

No, the decision to invite you for audition is based upon your application.

What happens at the audition?

The audition will be a group workshop audition followed by an individual audition and interview, you will need to prepare a 1-minute monologue and verse and chorus of any song.
