Osterley Park 10k

The UK's Number One triple gold award winning Ealing Half Marathon and Osterley Park and House are delighted to announce details of the next Osterley Park Summer 10k race at 10:30am on Saturday 17th June 2017.

The organisers are privileged to be working with Osterley Park to provide a unique route in and around the grounds which also takes in the private gardens behind the house.

This amazing 10k has limited places so don't miss out. And how about doing the double and starting at 9:00am at Osterley parkrun??

This UKA measured race is £18.00 for affiliated runners and £20.00 for non-affiliated runners and includes chip timing. Runners must be a minimum entry age of 17 on race day.

They are also delighted to announce that the Osterley Park 10k has been chosen to be the recommended race for Alice's Youth Music Memorial Fund.

Alice Gross was born in London on February 14, 2000, a Valentine's baby, and her life was cruelly taken from her. She went missing on 28th August 2014 and was found on 30th September. She was a keen musician, who wrote and sang her own songs. She played the violin and piano and could turn her hand to any instrument – she was learning the guitar and hoped, eventually, to have a career in music.

Alice's mother Ros Hodgkiss said "I am delighted that the Osterley 10K has linked up with Alice's Youth Music Memorial Fund as their nominated charity. I am extremely grateful to all those who decide to run on behalf of Alice's fund.

"Alice often teased me about my running, an activity that I took up when I hit 50, but she also encouraged me enormously and I know that she would want me to keep doing it. Alice was there when I completed my first 10k run at Osterley Park in 2014 and she would be proud to see that I am still running."
