Did You Know?

Pocahontas

One of the most famous visitors to Brentford is the Native American lady named Pocahontas (c.1595 – March 21, 1617) who married an Englishman, John Rolfe, and became a celebrity in London in the last year of her life. Pocahontas and Rolfe lived in Brentford for about six months in a house on the site that is now the Royal Mail sorting office (next to Pets at home). It is assumed that they got to know the 9th Earl of Northumberland's brother George Percy when he was for a short period governor of Jamestown in 1607. This may have led to the invitation to Brentford. Also the air to the west of London was thought to have been suggested as good for Pocahontas' health. Shortly after leaving Brentford she died and was buried at Gravesend.



Begging

The police were asked to combat begging in the town centre. They have completed an operation focused on begging and have arrested 3 people - all of whom have been charged and sent to court. They have also been given warnings by the London Borough of Hounslow in respect of this and if they persist the council will take action against them. The police continue to work with partner agencies towards resolving this issue.
